The McCarty Ranch Preserve is taking on a water quality restoration/storage project that will take approximately 1,871 acres of fallow citrus grove and a 730-acre water impoundment and convert them into a shallow water storage facility, consisting of 7 reservoirs capable of receiving water diverted from the C-23 Canal along with capturing an annual average of 53 inches of rain on the property, reducing the need to discharge.
